



Never give up & Carry-on Skillset growths & keep on submitting EU applications the time of funding will come...



Experience in Consortium in **EU Applications**

The templates only give rough information & experience over years pays off to understand & fill templates correctly

Check PIC number of participants (e.g., some send you their picture)

- Weekly Phone calls essential to progress → schedule until submission
- Check template constraints: font sizes, margins (i.e., google different vs. word)
- Check funding ratios: 50%, 125%, etc.
- Extend the consortium not with friends of friends of friends -> complementarity
- Press on partners to deliver with daily reminders → budget according inputs
- Template offers many chances for fine tuning & save space (e.g., tables)

Good Figures

Can be re-used in many proposals and adapted for specific needs & save text space



Coverage of EU

Integrating partners with wider coverage in the EU countries is usually essential

Never was easier to submit EU applications Informaion, EU Strategies & Policies also clearly available

- Good news: Digital/Horizon Europe
 - ✓ Often less pages (e.g., 45 vs. 70)
 - ✓ EU Portal stability improved over FP5, FP6, FP7, Horizon 2020
 - ✓ More have know-how now
